What's New

Airport

The new Salt Lake City International Airport (SLC) opened the doors to the first phase of the \$4.5 billion project in September 2020, which included a new terminal, new parking garage, and the west end of two new concourses complete with a varied menu of new restaurants and retail shops. Now, phase 2 is underway, encompassing the build out of Concourse A-east along with a tunnel connecting A and B concourses, while Phase 3 will include additional gates in Concourse B-east. The second phase is slated to be completed in 2024, and when finished, the airport will be a state-of-the-art facility with one large, central terminal and two linear concourses connected by a passenger tunnel, with more space and conveniences to give passengers a world-class airport experience. The terminal and concourses are designed to meet high environmental standards and aims to meet LEED Gold rating from the U.S. Green Building Council. TRAX Light Rail

The new airport UTA TRAX light rail station transports visitors from the Salt Lake City International Airport to downtown destinations in minutes. The Airport Station is conveniently located on the ground level near the baggage area and serves as one end of the TRAX Green Line with several transfer points available. TRAX Green Line trains depart the airport every 15 minutes, Monday through Sunday, from 5:37 a.m. to 11:22 p.m.

- Fares are as low as \$5 for an all-day pass, which also includes access to FrontRunner commuter trains, TRAX light rail trains, Bus, Ski Bus, SLC-Park City Connect, Paratransit and UTA on Demand Rideshare. FrontRunner allows visitors to travel north and south from Ogden to Provo. While TRAX, Bus and Rideshare offer east and west access throughout Salt Lake City.

Hotels

Over 1,000 new hotel rooms are under construction across Salt Lake County including the 26-story, 700-room Hyatt Regency Convention Center Hotel attached to the Salt Palace Convention Center and scheduled to open in October 2022. This beautiful new hotel will feature an array of dining options and a rooftop terrace with a heated pool and cabanas, along with 31 multifunctional meeting and event spaces.

The Salt Palace-adjacent West Quarter development project will be home to two new Marriottbranded hotels with an additional 270 hotel rooms – the boutique Le Meridian and the extended stay Element hotel, both slated to open in 2022. In the West Quarter, rooftop bars and ground level retail and restaurants will make for a walkable connection to Salt Lake's west side.

Additionally, the new 50-room evo Hotel, located in the Granary District as part of evo's historic Campus Salt Lake building, opened in the first half of 2022, and the historic Union Pacific building in downtown Salt Lake is undergoing a redevelopment into a 225-room luxury hotel on track to open in 2024.

Restaurants & Bars

Over the past decade, Salt Lake has become a legitimate destination for food-lovers with more than 50 new restaurants and bars. The busy downtown area offers flavors from all over the world – sample small plates or share family portions, try avant-garde cuisine, savor local ingredients, or find favorite staple dishes. Overall, the food and drink scene has exploded, earning prestigious James Beard awards, and scooping up medals galore from brewery and distillery bashes.
